

**Scurry County Appraisal District Business Renditions are due this Friday, May 15.**

Chief Appraiser Jackie Martin granted an automatic 30-day extension for business personal property renditions, moving the deadline from April 15 to May 15. This Friday, May 15, is the postmark deadline for business personal property renditions.

Any business owned and managed as of Jan. 1, 2020 must report their property to the appraisal district. Section 22.01 of the Texas Property Tax Code requires owners of business personal property to render or report all personal property used for the production of income. Examples include computers, chairs, desks, business inventory, machinery and vehicles used to produce income. Businesses not filing, filing late, or filing incomplete forms will result in a 10% penalty.

The Scurry County Appraisal District building is open and operating during normal business hours with limited public access due to Covid-19 distancing rules. As of May 11, access is by appointment only. Please call or email to make an appointment. On May 18, the appraisal district will increase public access to the lobby with surgical face mask or covering. Public access notifications will be posted on the front door of the appraisal district building and the website [www.scurrytex.com](http://www.scurrytex.com).
