BUSINESS PERSONAL PROPERTY RENDITION GUIDE

ATTN: RENDITION DEADLINE IS APRIL 15, 2026

Please complete the rendition form accurately for your business as of JANUARY 1, 2026.

The enclosed rendition is a document that all persons and companies are required by state law to complete if they have furniture, fixtures, equipment, vehicles, or other assets used in the production of income.

A new provision in law has increased the exemption amount to \$125,000 for a company or individual who owns income producing property. The exemption will be applied after the rendition is completed in 2026 and no further rendition will be required unless the business personal property value exceeds \$125,000 in future years. In Section 5, the owner or agent should check the appropriate boxes. If the box is marked "\$125,000 or less", then the property will be exempted from taxation unless the property value rises above that amount in future years.

People or companies who own income producing property that exceeds \$125,000 will file as normal and continue to file each year until the property in this jurisdiction falls below the exemption threshold. The exemption amount will be subtracted from the total value to yield a taxable value for the upcoming tax year.

A taxpayer may file a declaration stating their business personal property is valued at less than \$125,000 in lieu of filing the rendition. The property must be described in the declaration.
